Superintendent Update from Dr. Machesky: World Class 2020 Four Pillars of Learning. Prioritize Learning (professional and student development), Empower Students to Connect Learning to their World, Attend to Well-Being (support and meaningful connections), Invest in Early Childhood. ECE center infrastructure due to be completed in Fall of 2019, early bird registration is January 2019. Student Achievement: standardized tests are a snapshot in time TSD is proud to be tops in county in several areas. Achievement gaps of English language learners and economically disadvantaged students closing. Video: Wass Elementary models reading curriculum targeting all levels of child. New Website: more video content generated by students and staff coming in January. New computer system rollout had some hiccups but confident that the resources will be the most user-friendly for families and staff going forward. Sinking Fund spending from last summer was around \$10 million, with projects in every building. Hamilton Parking Lot slated for update next summer. Education millage on the ballot Nov. 6th for all voters to approve non-homestead properties keeping current tax rate. Voting yes means TSD can maintain funding and budget at current level
